CPD Overview

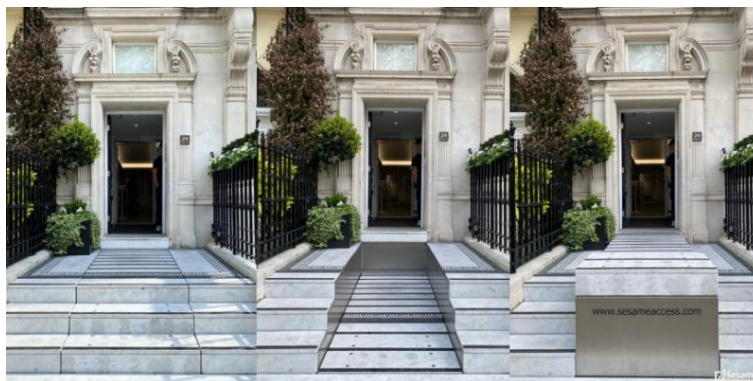
